# American Recovery Reinvestment Act

- US Department of Energy Funding \$14,994,183
- Total Project Cost \$35,111,275 (w/cost share)
- Projects Status
  - Vehicles - 38 of 143 on the road
  - Stations - 1 of 6 completed
  - \$3.6M of funding drawn down to date



# GLICCC Statistics

- Stakeholders – 452
- Number of AFV's operated by Stakeholders – 2,026
- Greenhouse gases displaced per year – 21,000+ tons
- Gallons of conventional fuel displaced – 10M+ gallons
- Raised over \$30M !!
